The Licence to carry out Electrical Installation work in J&K UT, subject to the following conditions:-

1) This Licence authorities the electrical contact, to whom it is granted, to carry out electrical installation work of low tension, medium pressure only and high tension work up to 11KV throughout the J&K UT.

Provided that:

- a) Where the electrical contractor conduct his business from one or more than one branch established in a single tehsil, he may employ one or more electrical supervisors and be in possession of one or more sets of instruments on the strength of which the licence is granted to him.
- b) Where an electrical contractor re-employing only one supervisor and possessing only one set of instruments conducts his business from one or more than one branch established in single tehsil, he may not undertake electrical installation work in another tehsil unless; -
 - I) He employs an additional supervisor for the work at such other tehsils and is in possession of additional set of instruments : or
 - II) He suspends all work in the tehsil in which his business is normally conducted while the work at such other tehsil is in progress.
 - III) The electrical contractor shall keep the instruments in good order.
 - IV) The electrical Contractor shall at all times offer all reasonable facilities to the Superintending Engineer, Inspections, Jammu or his representative for examining and resting any or all of the instrument in his possession.
 - V) The electrical contractor shall notify to the Superintending Engineer, Inspections, Jammu for the purpose of Rules 45 of the J&K Electricity Rules, the namesor certificate No./Nos. of the Supervisor/Supervisor employed by him. The Contractor shall also inform the Superintending Engineer, when his supervisor leaves his service.
 - VI) Test Report :- After the completion of an electrical installation, work to which Rule 45 of the J&K Electricity Rules applies shall be submitted by licenses electrical contractor to the electrical supply undertaking concerned. The lost a test report shall be signed by the supervisor under whose supervision the work has been carried out and countersigned by the electrical contractor.
 - VII) If the electrical contractor's adjudged by the Superintending Engineer, Inspections, to be quality of misconduct, carelessness or any malpractise, the Superintending Engineer may suspend or cancel his license.
 - VIII) The Superintending Engineer, Inspections, may if the contractor commits a breach of any of terms and conditions of his license for any other sufficient cause suspend or cancel his license.
 - IX) The Government may suspend or cancel this licence , without as given reason.
 - X) If in the opinion of the Superintending Engineer, Inspections, prima facie case of misconduct and/or gross violation of the Electrical Act or Rules exists against contractor the Superintending Engineer, Inspections may suspend the licence of such a contractor.
 - XI) This Licence Shall be renewable annually and if it is not renewed on due date it shall automatically lapse full initial fee will be chargeable for the issue of as new licence.

XII) If the holders or all of the holders of certificate of competency on yhe strength of whose certificate the licence has been granted leaves/leave the service of contractor, the contractor's licence shall be deemed to have been suspended and it shall remain suspended until such time as the contractor against employs a person holding a certificate of competency.

XIII) If the licence has been granted to contractor on the strength of certificate of competency held by him in his own name, the licence shall stand automatically cancelled in the event of the contract accepting employment under any other electrical contractor.

XIV) Supervisor shall not be employed in a part time capacity nor shall they be in the employ of more than one contractor at one and the same time.

XV) Notice of commencement of Work :- Notice of electrical installation work including addition, alterations, repairs and adjustments to existing except such replacement of Lamps, Fan, Fuse, switches and other component parts of the installations as in no way alters its capacity or character shall be given in writing by a licenced Electrical Contractor to the Superintending Engineer, Inspections, or his Assistant within 48 hours of the commencement of such work and simultaneously the supplier's local informed of it. XVI) Staff of Contractor :-

- a) All the wireman of the electrical contractor shall be bona fide and whole time Wireman holding 'A' Class wiring licence granted by the Superintending Engineer, Inspections, provided that a contractor may appoint apprentice for training purpose in which case number of apprentices employed bby any contractor at any time shall not exceed 10% of his total wiring staff, inclusive of coolies: provided further that the contractor shall not permit such apprentices a certificate of competency and the guidance of at least and certified wireman on the premises.
- b) Every contractor shall maintained two registers, the first being the register of supervisor Wireman and apprentices employed by him on Form 'K' attached and the other being the daily attendance register of all Supervisors, Wireman and employed by him on for 'L' attached. No person whose name is not entered in such registers shall be concerned to be bona fide employee on the contractor,s wiring staff.

XVII) Installation work to comply code of Practice :- The Electrical Installation work and fittings in buildings shall comply with the IS: 732-1963.
